Every year, the Suffolk Owl Sanctuary receives many calls for help to rescue injured or distressed owls and other birds of prey.

"Calamity Jane" shown here was one of our recent cases - the poor thing had managed to get herself trapped down a chimney where she remained for some hours before being extricated, only to arrive back at our HQ in a rather sorry and very sooty state!

Nevertheless, a lengthy and very careful clean-up took place, and after a few days rest in our recuperation aviaries, this Tawny Owl was released back to the wild safe & sound from whence she came.

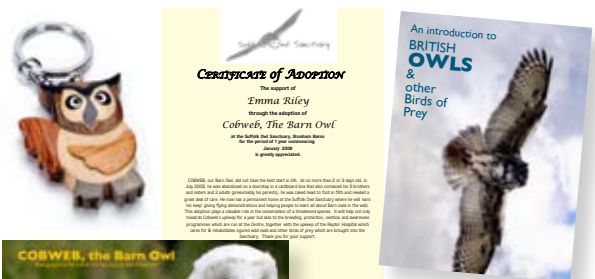
